- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Cheshire Peaks & Plains Housing Trust Limited or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Cheshire Peaks & Plains Housing Trust Limited asks you to.
